Thank you for your interest in applying for a scholarship. Northcott and The SpineCare Foundation proudly administer these important opportunities for funding and support of your tertiary education.

In brief, the scholarship offerings are;

The Gregory and Dolores Farrell Scholarship: for students attending university who use a wheelchair as a primary form of mobility. This includes students from NSW progressing to post-graduate study in Australia or abroad.

The Thomas K.F. Taylor Scholarship: for students attending university, who use a wheelchair as a primary form of mobility. Priority access is for those studying in the fields of medicine, health or science.

The Thomas Hepburn Lennox Scholarship: for past and present Northcott customers, with a physical disability attending university, TAFE College or other Accredited Training Organisation. Priority access is for those from financially disadvantaged backgrounds.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

1. Scholarships are only for students with a disability and/or those who use a wheelchair for mobility. Applicants must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident, accepted into or enrolled in tertiary study in NSW. Students who meet the above conditions proceeding to post-graduate study within Australia, or at an internationally recognised institution, are also welcome to apply.
2. Applications must be lodged by the close of business on **Wednesday 28 January 2026** via email scholarships@northcott.com.au
3. Short listed applicants will need to attend an interview on **Wednesday 11 February 2026**, either in person at the Northcott, North Parramatta Office or via videoconference.
4. Successful applicants will need to produce evidence of enrolment prior to confirmation of award and release of payment. The scholarship is paid in two biannual instalments (February and August).
5. Awarded students must submit mid and end of year results, evidence of expenditure (receipts) as well as a short report on study experience and impact of scholarship support.
6. Unsatisfactory academic performance needs to be discussed with the associated Scholarship Advisory Committee and may impact continuation of scholarship.
7. Funding is for one year only, however awarded students are invited to apply for continuation of scholarship on the provision that scholarship conditions have been satisfied.
8. Change of circumstances (deferral of studies, change of course or pattern of study i.e. full-time to part-time study) needs to be communicated with the associated Scholarship Advisory Committee.
9. Unspent funds will need to be returned at the end of the scholarship year or otherwise negotiated with the associated Scholarship Advisory Committee.
